

Open Countryside One Planet Development One Day Training Course

Open Countryside One Planet Development (OCOPD) is a type of development supported by national policy in Wales, with application numbers now increasing. It encapsulates a cutting edge of rural sustainability, and is very carefully and precisely prescribed by detailed Practice Guidance in order to prevent abuse.

This course is aimed at planning officers, but may also be of interest to other professionals involved in the production, assessment or monitoring of One Planet Developments. We will present a detailed introduction to the essentials of OCOPD, its Welsh planning policy context and implementation in practice. Delivering the course is the principal author of the Practice Guidance, James Shorten, of Geo Ltd. Erica Thompson, chair of the One Planet Council, will also give an overview of current One Planet Developments. Both will be available for Q&A.

The guidance is necessarily complex, and deals with aspects of development not found in other types of planning proposals. However, at the end of the day participants should be confident that they know what OCOPD is, what is required of planning proposals for it, and how to assess the authenticity and integrity of OCOPD planning applications.

The course will be delivered to small groups, on an informal basis, allowing time for questions and discussions as the session progresses.

The course is organised by the One Planet Council (OPC), an independent voluntary body which enables and promotes One Planet Development. James Shorten is supporting the course at the request of the OPC as independent and impartial expert.
